Timeline

Students should finish all three courses by the time fall of their 3rd year ends.



Students may plan to take ELPS 351/352 as early as spring 2nd year or at the latest, spring 3rd year.



These courses are completed any time senior year.



Core Curriculum (Take ELPS 207 in fall and then ELPS 217 in spring)

Students must take ELPS 217 (spring) after ELPS 207 (fall). ELPS 350 may be taken before, alongside, or after ELPS 217.

Selecting and planning a capstone project (Must have completed ELPS 207, ELPS 217, & ELPS 350)

Students should meet with an LSM program advisor (and Honors & Scholars coach if relevant) to identify if they will do a Self-Directed or Department Approved Capstone Project and then register for either ELPS 351 or ELPS 352, respectively.

ELPS 351 (1 hours)

Personally & Socially Responsible Leadership (for Department Approved Capstones)

Students who take ELPS 351 must take at least **3 credit hours** of capstone credit from the academic department associated with their capstone project. Students doing a self-directed project may ignore this step.

OR

ELPS 352 (3 hours)

Personally & Socially Responsible Leadership in Action (for Self-Directed Capstones)

ELPS 493 (1 hour)

Ind. Study

Taken senior year; students write 20-25 page white paper justifying self-directed capstone.
